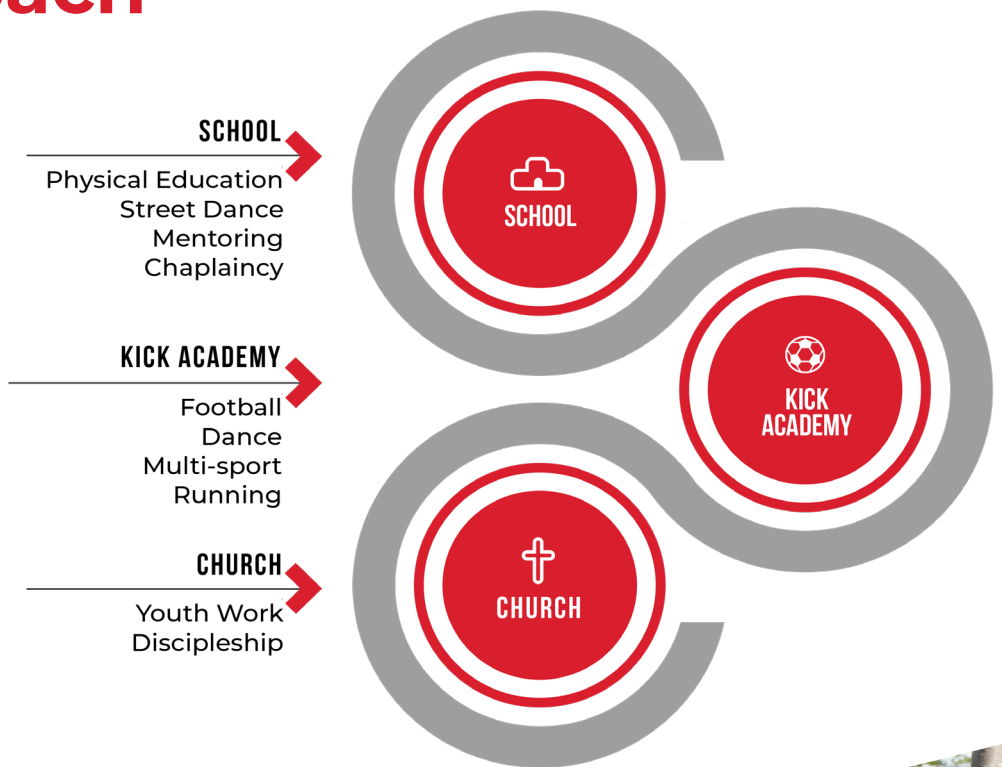
# KICK ACADEMIES

At KICK our mission is to transform young peoples lives with God's love through sport. We believe that by engaging young people through active, exciting subjects such as sport, we can see young people engage with education and have an enriched experience of school.

## Hope for the future, joy in the present

### Our Approach

Our model works by engaging the young people in coaching, linked to a theme, illustrating that theme with an inspirational thought from the Bible and then putting their learning into practise with matches/routines. For example, the theme that day may have been 'aspiration' – so they focus on their passing, heading and shooting. Then in the sports ministry slot, the young people are taught about an inspirational story about the theme from the Bible – where Peter aspired to focus his eyes on Jesus and got out of the boat to meet Him in faith. This is a seamless switch and one, which engages the young people as we share using sport. We have found that Kick Academies can work well with both Primary or Secondary age split.

**Multiple pathways** - You can select resources for a football, street dance, multi-sport or running KICK Academy to suit to the needs and interests of your local community.



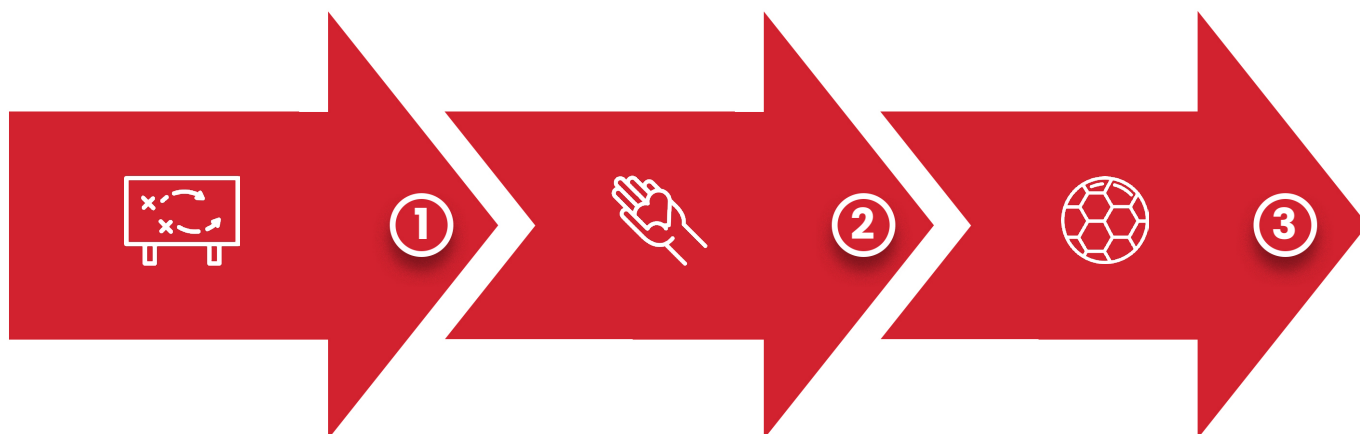
**Our sustainable model** - We train local volunteers to engage local young people in your local community so that you don't have endless costs by hiring professionals.
